

Join Bibles for Believers on an Outreach / Bible Placement

Bibles for Believers often arranges opportunities for our partners to join us on a ministry trip. We regularly have teams from the USA and South Africa – from different denominations join us.

There are two types of trips that you could get involved in:

1. Bible Placement Trips

These trips are aimed solely at taking Bibles to Churches that have applied for them. Bibles for Believers needs volunteers and vehicles to enable us to reach each village Church in the targeted area.

2. Outreach and Bible Placement

Bibles for Believers joins Harvesters International Ministries on organised outreaches to specific areas where Bibles are needed. Here participants can be involved in the outreach side or the Bible placement side of the trip or in both.

Duration

Trips take between one and two weeks. Generally we work from Sunday to Sunday with travel time either side.

Place

Trips are currently being planned to Zambia, Malawi, Mozambique and Zambia. Travel time differs and can be anywhere from one day to three days in one direction.

Who Can Go?

Anyone who knows and loves the Lord is welcome to join us provided:

1. That you are in good health and can travel.
2. Have a valid passport.

Cost

Cost varies depending on the distance to the place of placement. Please contact us regarding specific trips.

N.B.!! People providing vehicles (4x4 or 2x4) are seen as volunteer staff and do not pay. All the travel expenses associated with the vehicle they provide are covered by Bibles for Believers, including fuel and border costs. Put your vehicle to work!!!

What Will I do on a Trip?

On all trips we need cooks and camp site co-ordinators, drivers and admin staff. We also need people who will visit the churches and physically hand out Bibles. On outreaches we need team members who will go out with local believers, mentoring evangelism to them. No prior training is required.

Basic Daily Program – Bible Placement Outreach

- Breakfast.
- Joint devotions and feedback of previous days work.
- Load Bibles.
- Travel to various churches and hand over Bibles.
- Lunch on the road.
- Visit more churches.
- Back to campsite.
- Supper.
- Fellowship.

Outreach Daily Program

- Breakfast.
- Joint devotions and feedback of previous days work.
- *Bible placers do as above.
- Outreach participants travel to participating churches.
- Training session with local believers. (materials provided)
- Take local believers out witnessing.
- Lunch 'on the go. '
- Further evangelism.
- Back to camp.
- Supper.
- Teams go out to show 'Jesus Film.'
